

PBYC - Junior Sailing Program Participation Agreement

Note: Both the student and a parent or legal guardian must read and sign this form before the student may participate in the Sailing Program.

Sailing, like other sports, involves a risk of injury. Risks include, but are not limited to, the following. Students will be sailing in water which is over their heads in depth; conditions which can not be anticipated may cause boats to capsize; parts of the boats may cause injury, even without extenuating circumstance or condition; exposure to elements aboard an open boat can result in sunburn and hypo or hyper-thermia; submerged debris, as well as shell fish, can result in painful cuts.

Students will receive instruction and training to mitigate these risks as endorsed by the US Sailing Association. It is vital that all students listen to, understand, and follow, these instructions. Red Cross Standard First Aide and CPR qualified instructors are on hand to handle any injuries that may occur.

We, the undersigned, have read this and other available information regarding risks related to sailing. We understand and freely assume any and all risks involved in participation in the PBYC Junior Sailing Program. We further release the Pensacola Beach Yacht Club and its officers, members, instructors, employees, volunteers or any of their assigns from any liability arising from or connected with participation in the PBYC Junior Sailing Program.
